### **Missionary: Mentor/Discipleship Assistant**

Reports to: Director of Casa Ester

Full-Time Exempt

Location: San Lucas, Guatemala

This is a missionary position for which the individual raises funds for their salary and expenses.

Kids Alive International is a Christian organization serving vulnerable at-risk children in multiple countries across the globe.

We are seeking a new Mentor/Discipleship Assistant to assist the director of our Casa Ester program. This program seeks to launch girls, 18 years of age or older, back into Guatemalan society by teaching them various culturally appropriate life skills and discipling them to have the strength and courage to become independent as Christian young women in a developing country often with limited opportunities.

The Mentor/Discipleship Assistant will work with girls both on our Casa Ester campus and around the greater San Lucas area to provide opportunities to see and aspire to independent living. It will be important to disciple the girls, keeping in mind Deuteronomy 6:6-8 (...Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. ...) for most of the girls have not enjoyed Christian counseling, nurture or guidance from their home environment.

Successful applicants will need to have good (not excellent...you can also learn-on-the-job!!) Spanish language skills and be a clear, compassionate and passionate communicator! Creativity is always a plus and an applicant should display the willingness to share their life with young women.

### **As a Mentor/Discipleship Assistant, you will:**

- Seek out opportunities in various environments to teach life skills
- Weave Christian doctrine and teaching into daily situations much the way Jesus taught
- Provide opportunities for girls to make choices and learn the impact of good and poor choices

### **A successful Mentor/Discipleship Assistant will also bring:**

- BA or BS degree
- No experience with teaching life skills required
- High interpersonal awareness and emotional intelligence
- Excellent organizational skills
- Proficiency with Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint may be helpful
- Fluency in English reading, writing, speaking, and listening
- Full vaccination against COVID-19, or a willingness to get the vaccine
- Preferred fluency in Spanish (or attend language school in Guatemala for 3-4 months)

We seek candidates with alignment to the Bible, Christian theology, faith, and practice, as well as our organization's mission, vision, and core values.
