



Finding Christ in Zambia

Once Abandoned to the Streets,
Twins Find Christ in Lusaka

A boy and a girl, teenage twins (15), were on their own, abandoned by family, begging and stealing to survive on the rough streets of Lusaka, Zambia.

Sepiso* and Sitali*'s prospects changed when Kids Alive Zambia welcomed them at Chikondi Children's Village.

Moving from survival on the streets, fending for themselves, to being in the care and supervision of a family-style home wasn't easy for Sepiso and Sitali.

Because they had adapted to their unhealthy and unstructured environment, they struggled to build trust in their new caretakers. They exhibited this through challenging behaviors such as disrespecting others and refusing to partake in anything spiritual. Who can blame them?

Their attitudes and behaviors changed over the next few weeks as they witnessed God's love through the Kids Alive staff and partook in Bible study sessions. Sepiso and Sitali gave their lives to Christ.

Today, they cling to their new Bibles, attend services at a local Church, and participate in their programs.

Restoring a Broken Home in Lebanon

Two brothers roamed the streets of Lebanon without food, proper clothes, or schooling. Jad* (8) and Salem* (7) only had each other.

They were born out of wedlock to a Lebanese father and an Ethiopian mother, a circumstance creating citizenship status issues. The father's drug addiction led to fits of violence that drove the mother to flee and the children to roam the streets with each outbreak.

In July 2022, the juvenile court placed the boys in Kids Alive Lebanon's residential program.

At first, Jad and Salem had a hard time adjusting. They were aggressive and uncooperative. Kids Alive Lebanon's trauma-responsive team made them feel welcome, prioritizing their physical, mental, educational, and spiritual needs. The boys softened, felt safe, and grew healthier in the loving atmosphere.

Meanwhile, the father enrolled in a rehab program, and the Kids Alive staff located the mother to give her the good news that her boys were safe and doing well at Kids Alive Lebanon. We are working with both parents, helping them heal. They plan to marry and provide a loving environment for their children.

Performed 5,257 on-site therapy sessions by licensed staff therapists. Invested 4,992 hours in therapy sessions.



We invested **7,879** hours in trauma training for staff.

Provided 5.568 supplementary/ non-urgent health care interventions, including yearly checkups, labs, dental care, surgery, physical therapy, and more.







We provided **380,618** nutritious meals to children, teenagers, and young adults in our residential care facilities, schools, and care centers.

Serving Christ in the Dominican Republic

She was twelve, neglected and abandoned by her family, and forced to become a domestic servant. Life was unbearable for Rebeca*.

She arrived at Kids Alive Dominican Republic out of these dire circumstances. The staff warmly welcomed her, enrolling her in our Christ-centered, holistic education program, where she began to heal from her trauma.

Rebeca thrived at our school, receiving an education that included instruction in God's word. Throughout her journey, God transformed her heart, preparing her for a life of independence and service. Rebeca enrolled in a university made possible by a Kids Alive scholarship and earned her degree.



Today, Rebeca is a teacher at the Kids Alive school. She's passionate and knowledgeable, instilling the values she learned at Kids Alive in the next generation of students.

Making Justice Accessible in Guatemala

Keilin* lived a happy childhood with her mom until she was five. That's when her father came into their lives. A joyous occasion turned into terror as he began to abuse his daughter sexually.

Keilin was bewildered, wondering why daddy was hurting her. She felt she had nowhere to go, no one to turn to. Her oppressor took advantage of Keilin's fearful silence for nearly a decade.

One day, Keilin, now 14, broke the silence, confiding in her friends and mother. Her mom went to the police, and they arrested the father.

Kids Alive Guatemala's Escuintla Justice Center took the case. Meanwhile, Keilin was placed in our Oasis Residential Care, where she accepted Jesus into her life, giving her a new-found identity in Christ that helped her overcome fear and self-loathing.

Keilin boldly testified in court against her father, who got 42 years in prison. Keilin and her mom are doing great, living free of fear and violence.






Operating Expenses Total Expenses \$15,788,482



Dianne Sivulka is a supporter of Kids Alive International from Southern California.

"I first heard about Kids Alive when I heard

Corbey Dukes speak at a Christian function. I visited Guatemala in June 2021 and was convinced this was a wonderful ministry when I saw their impact on the community.

"The most important thing to me is that local, national staff shepherd the work. I was impressed that Guatemalans with higher education used their talents to serve their people.

"I also love Kids Alive's approach to restoration. We're created in God's image and loved by Him. That belief guides their methodology to help the girls heal from their trauma. I see the brokenness in all of us, and that encourages me to bring God's love back home and share it."

Dianne's love for ministry inspired her to start an organization called Travel on Purpose.

"I want to change the way we travel for vacations. Travel on Purpose looks beyond fancy hotels and ventures into the local culture. We want to introduce vacationers to an organization that is doing something about the challenges that part of the world faces. For example, there is a high rate of sexual abuse of young girls in Guatemala, and Kids Alive is doing something about it. So, our Travel on Purpose group takes time on their vacation to go on a learning journey. I have now led seven tours to Kids Alive Guatemala in two years."

Dianne explains why people should partner with Kids Alive.

"When you support an organization like Kids Alive, it's not just about the child, but their family and community. We can help change a nation."



Over a century ago, Leslie and Ava Anglin left their home in Georgia to bring Christ-centered education to the children of China. Their multifaceted approach was ahead of its time, for the Anglins were determined to make a difference in every aspect of a child's life – physical, spiritual, and intellectual. Their unique ministry eventually spread worldwide, serving over 3,000 children annually.

It's amazing to think that all these years later, we've come full circle, with our ministry now based in Georgia, where the Anglin's first set out in faith so long ago. The future looks bright, for we continue to bring our approach of "Justice that Heals" to children in need. We're breaking the silence, giving children a voice, and helping them overcome their trauma while building a relationship with God and learning important life skills.

We're not stopping there! We have plans to open justice and hope centers in Guatemala, Peru, Zambia, and Kenya because we're committed to expanding our services and bringing Christ to more children and communities around the world.
